

House Rules De Pul Uden (Part of Compass Uden)

1. These *House Rules* apply to all visitors to events at De Pul and events organized by De Pul at other locations. These house rules can also be read at the entrance and can be found on www.livepul.com.

2. The Dutch Venue and Festival Association's (VNPF) *General Terms and Conditions for Visitors* also apply. These conditions can be found on www.livepul.com and can be read at De Pul's pay desk.

3. Visitors can be exposed to noise levels above 83dBA at De Pul. De Pul advises visitors to wear hearing protection. Earplugs are available at De Pul. Protection of hearing is under the responsibility of visitors.

4. Identification is mandatory for activities that have a minimum age. No access is granted without valid identification. For all other activities, we advise adult guidance (18+) for visitors up to and including 14 years of age.

5. De Pul does not serve alcohol to visitors under the age of 18. The purchase of alcohol at De Pul requires valid identification. Visitors are strictly forbidden to resell alcohol or pass it on to persons under the age of 18. Visitors under the age of 18 are also not permitted to accept or consume alcohol. Upon detection of violation, access will be denied.

6. De Pul prohibits the trade in soft and hard drugs, as well as the use of hard drugs. With regard to the use of and trade in hard drugs, De Pul applies a zero-tolerance policy. The police are called in on the detection of trade and / or the finding of drugs.

7. Visitors under the influence of alcohol and / or drugs will be denied access.

8. Tokens are being used to pay for consumptions at De Pul. Tokens are available at the token machines (cash and cashless). In addition, card payments are also accepted at the pay desk and the bar.

9. Smoking (also by means of an E-Cigarette) is not permitted. Any fines imposed by the visitor on the organization as a result of the violation will be recovered from the visitor.

10. At De Pul, it is not permitted:

- to possess weapons, dangerous / sharp objects, or other objects or

substances that may cause harm or nuisance,

- to have markers, spray cans or stickers,
- to use professional recording equipment for sound or images without permission,
- to distribute flyers or other promotional material in and around the building,
- to take glasses or bottles, with or without contents, outside,
- to bring your own consumptions,
- to bring medication without medical prescription,
- to bring animals without permission.

11. De Pul reserves the right to refuse access to anyone with offensive clothing and / or clothing related to a club of any kind.

12. Emerged damage is recovered from the causer.

13. Artists, organizers of productions and De Pul are entitled to make image and / or sound recordings of events, including the audience. This material may be made public and multiplied. Persons who appear in the recordings consent to this by attending the event, without being entitled to any compensation.

14. There is camera surveillance throughout the entire building. Camera footage is kept for 14 days and made available to the police if necessary.

15. Documentation of events in any form (photographing, filming, sound recording) is prohibited. Registrations may be seized and destroyed by De Pul.

16. In all cases where the *House Rules* and *General Terms and Conditions for Visitors* do not accommodate, De Pul staff decides. These decisions are binding.
